# A BILL

To prohibit the Administrator of General Services from leasing space for certain purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Office Space for  
5 Executive Amnesty Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON GSA LEASING AUTHORITY.**

7 No funds may be obligated or expended by the Ad-  
8 ministrator of General Services to lease any space for pur-  
9 poses of carrying out the policies set forth in the following:

1           (1) The memorandum from the Secretary of  
2           Homeland Security entitled “Southern Border and  
3           Approaches Campaign” dated November 20, 2014.

4           (2) The memorandum from the Secretary of  
5           Homeland Security entitled “Policies for the Appre-  
6           hension, Detention and Removal of Undocumented  
7           Immigrants” dated November 20, 2014.

8           (3) The memorandum from the Secretary of  
9           Homeland Security entitled “Secure Communities”  
10          dated November 20, 2014.

11          (4) The memorandum from the Secretary of  
12          Homeland Security entitled “Exercising Prosecu-  
13          torial Discretion with Respect to Individuals Who  
14          Came to the United States as Children and with Re-  
15          spect to Certain Individuals Who Are the Parents of  
16          U.S. Citizens or Permanent Residents” dated No-  
17          vember 20, 2014.

18          (5) The memorandum from the Secretary of  
19          Homeland Security entitled “Expansion of the Pro-  
20          visional Waiver Program” dated November 20,  
21          2014.
