

SBA Information

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) is offering designated states and territories low-interest federal disaster loans for working capital to small businesses and private, non-profit organizations suffering substantial economic injury as a result of the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Upon a request received from the Governor of a state or territory, SBA will issue under its own authority, as provided by the [*Coronavirus Preparedness and Response Supplemental Appropriations Act*](#) (H.R. 6074) that was recently signed by President Trump, an Economic Injury Disaster Loan declaration.

Step 2: If your county has not been declared, complete [this form](#) – then, send it to your county's Emergency Management Coordinator to report economic injury:
