## **SBA Information**

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) is offering designated states and territories low-interest federal disaster loans for working capital to small businesses and private, non-profit organizations suffering substantial economic injury as a result of the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Upon a request received from the Governor of a state or territory, SBA will issue under its own authority, as provided by the *Coronavirus Preparedness and Response Supplemental Appropriations Act* (H.R. 6074) that was recently signed by President Trump, an Economic Injury Disaster Loan declaration.
